A blend of 2010, 2011 and 2012 fruit, some whole cluster pressed and some pressed by foot. Fermentations generally taking 20 days in plastic drums, though the 2011 barrel ferment went dry in 5 days. Substantial time was spent on lees without any stirring and it has gone through spontaneous malolactic fermentation. The vintages were mixed and only very lightly filtered for clarity. It has not been cold stabilized so tartrate crystals may form below 40°F if refrigerated.

The label image is from Herculaneum, just northwest of Pompeii, which was also destroyed in 79AD when Mount Vesuvius erupted. This area was part of the ancient home of Greco, approximately 40 miles from the location of the thriving Greco di Tufo DOCG today. The mosaic depicts the marriage of Neptune and Amphitrite, and the wall on which it appears is connected to one of the oldest and most immaculately preserved wine shops in all of Ancient Rome. Undoubtedly this ancient wine shop once new the Greco grape and held it in high esteem, unlike the TTB.
